

Bertram – Tummon Street Water Upgrade

Bertram – Tummon Streets, Walkervale

Issue 1– February 2020

Work will commence soon on a \$90,000 water infrastructure project to improve the water supply to Bertram and Tummon Streets, Walkervale.

This water infrastructure will consist of the replacement of water mains as indicated in yellow on the map.

Council's Water Services Team is involved with the construction of the water infrastructure. Construction is planned to commence in February 2020 and is expected to be completed during March 2020. During this time, construction work will be undertaken Monday to Friday between the hours of 7.00 am and 5.00 pm.

Traffic Management measures will be implemented during construction. Individual owners will be consulted if it is required to dig across their driveway during the course of construction.

The new water main has to be connected to the existing water network during which time there will be a disruption to the water service. Residents will be provided with prior notice in this event.

Bundaberg Regional Council is aware of the inconvenience construction work causes and thanks residents for their patience and co-operation. Should you have any concerns or queries regarding the water works, please call Council's Project Manager.
