Terms and Conditions General

- 1. This competition is run by the Bundaberg Regional Council (Council).
- 2. By entering this competition, you agree to abide by and be bound by these Terms and Conditions. A failure to comply with these Terms and Conditions will render any entry invalid and an entrant will be ineligible to claim the prize.
- 3. Entry to the competition is free. Entrants will be responsible for all other costs associated with entering the competition.
- 4. The competition is open from 22 June 2020 and will close on 5pm on 17 July 2020 (competition period). Council must receive your entry by that time.
- 5. The winner will be drawn on 20 July 2020 at Council's office at 190 Bourbong Street Bundaberg.

Eligibility

- 6. The competition is open to owners of rateable property registered within the Council local government area. Council employees and Councillors are ineligible to enter, as is any person who is a joint proprietor of land with a Council employee or Councillor within the local government area.
- 7. Government agencies are ineligible to enter.
- 8. Only one entry per rateable property will be accepted. Any additional entries will be invalid.
- 9. In order to be eligible to win the prize, you must elect to receive your Rates Notice by email by signing up for Council's eRates and complete a direct debit application during the competition period. In doing so, you must also agree to the terms and conditions of Council's eRates service.
- 10. Existing eRates customers may enter by signing up for direct debit during the competition period.
- 11. Direct Debit customers may enter by signing up for eRates during the competition period.

Prize

- 12. The prize is a maximum of \$1000 to be deducted from the next Rate Notice issued by Council. The prize is not transferable to another rating period or to a subsequent Rate Notice. A failure to accept the against the next Rate Notice issued will invalidate the prize
- 13. If the net amount payable shown on the Rate Notice is lower than \$1000 then the remainder of the prize will be held on the rate account as credit.
- 14. The prize cannot be taken in cash, in full or part, or be withdrawn as cash, in full or part, at any time.

Drawing the prize

- 15. The winner will be drawn at random from a computer-generated list of eligible entries.
- 16. The name of the winner will be posted on Council's website and be notified by phone, email or letter.
- 17. The Council's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 18. Council reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and to disqualify any entry that is not in accordance with the competition Terms and Conditions.
