



# Alexandra Park toilet upgrade

## Park improvement works, Bundaberg West

October 2020



### Project

The Alexandra Park toilet block has been identified for upgrade in the Bundaberg Regional Council Parks & Open Space Strategy 2019-2026 to meet the required standards for accessibility.

The new toilet facility will be located adjacent to the existing toilet facility.

The Alexandra Park toilet upgrade is a joint initiative of Bundaberg Regional Council and the Queensland Government.



### The project will involve:

- Demolition of the existing toilet block.
- Construction of two new toilet blocks.
- One toilet block will include a unisex accessible toilet and unisex ambulant toilet.
- The second toilet block will include a unisex accessible toilet with baby change table and a unisex toilet.
- Relocation of the water bubbler, seat, rubbish bin and bicycle rack.

Work will be undertaken in a staggered progression so that toilets will be available to the community for most of the time throughout the project.

During the demolition of the old toilet block there will be no access to toilets and the Alexandra Park Zoo will be closed for safety reasons.

The closest public toilets are in Alexandra Park West off Quay Street. The first toilet block is open during daylight hours and has disabled access. The second toilet block is open 24 hours and does not have disabled access.
