



# Creeveys and Hamanns Roads, Apple Tree Creek

## New Connecting Road Construction – Evacuation Route

Issue 1 – February 2021



Bundaberg Regional Council will be undertaking construction of a new connecting road from the end of Hamanns Road to Creeveys Road, Apple Tree Creek, as highlighted in yellow on the map above.

Work is planned to commence late February and will be undertaken weekdays, during the hours of 6.30 am and 5.00 pm. Weather permitting, work will be completed within twelve weeks.

During construction, this section of road will be closed to all traffic. Appropriate signage will be installed to assist motorists.

Stage 2 of the project includes upgrading the Hamanns and Duguid Road intersection. This work is scheduled to commence in late April.

The Site Supervisor will liaise with directly affected residents to facilitate property access during construction.

The Site Supervisor will also discuss where to place your wheelie bin prior to the day of collection where construction works conflict with your refuse collection.

Bundaberg Regional Council is aware of the inconvenience construction work causes and thanks residents and road users in advance for their patience and co-operation.
