## New play equipment

New play equipment and shade sails will be installed at South Head Parklands as identified in the Parks and Open Space Strategy 2019 – 2026 and Capital Works Program 2020/2021.

The upgrades will improve the park assets to meet community recreation needs and expectations and is in keeping with Council's infrastructure standards. Existing play equipment will be incorporated into this upgrade.

# **Community feedback**

The community has expressed the need for more play equipment in the park, play equipment that caters for a wider range of ages and shade over the play equipment.

This project will ensure this park is in line with community expectation.



# **Equipment**

This park upgrade will result in the development of three separate play areas to cater for children of all ages.

Toddler Play Area - new pieces of play equipment including a new slide, swings with a 'joey' seat, chimes panel, little train (pictured), play hut and play fort will cater for pre-school age children.



Junior Play Area - an all-abilities spinner, double swing and climbing and slide set (pictured below) will be aimed at primary age children.



Senior Play Area - a 6-metre tower (pictured on first page) and spinning orb will be provided for older children.

#### **Access**

During the project there will be no access to the existing playground for safety reasons. At times there may also be no access to the shelters and some of the nearby pathways. Access to the toilets will remain.

## **Funding**

The South Head Parklands playground is a joint initiative of Bundaberg Regional Council and the Queensland Government.
