



# Saltwater Creek Pedestrian Bridge

## Refurbishment

Issue 1 – June 2021



Bundaberg Regional Council will be undertaking refurbishments on the Saltwater Creek Pedestrian Bridge at Quay St East. Indicated in red on the above map. This bridge is also historically known as the Saltwater Creek Rail Bridge.

Work is planned to commence early June 2021 and will be undertaken weekdays, during the hours of 5.30 am and 5.00 pm. The bridge will be closed during the period of the works commencing Tuesday 1 June through to Monday 30 August, weather permitting.

Pedestrians and cyclists are asked to utilize Kennedy Bridge on Bourbong St as an alternative route. The Site Supervisor will liaise with directly affected residents to facilitate property access during construction.

Council advised residents to be aware of equipment and requests that all safety signage be adhered to.
