Tree planting

Bundaberg Regional Council will plant 34 mostly native trees in selected garden beds in the Bundaberg CBD to supplement the existing tree population.

Tree locations are indicated by yellow dots on the above map.

Aims of the project

Increasing the number of trees in the CBD will not only increase the visual appeal, but it will also provide a cooling effect through increased shade, encouraging shoppers to stay longer.





Removal of trees

As well as new trees in 29 locations throughout the CBD, five unhealthy trees will be replaced as part of this project, as indicated by the orange dots on the map over page.

Some of the existing hedges in the identified areas will also be replaced.

Types of trees

Nine species of trees have been selected for this project including Weeping lilly pilly, Ivory Curl, White Oak, Water Gum, Grey Myrtle, Pink Trumpet Tree, Brush Cherry, Riberry lilly pilly and Broad Leaved Paperbark.

They have been selected for their suitability to the business and streetscape environment and our climate.

Site selection

The sites have been selected as they do not currently have any trees located in them. This will increase the shade and street appeal throughout the CBD.

Tree protection

New trees will be protected by a mesh wire 'fence' while they become established.

Work operations

To minimise impact to businesses and traffic flow, Council will undertake the required work prior to 9 am on weekdays.

For safety and access reasons the car parks either side of the garden bed will be used by staff during work, with access provided once work is complete. There will be some noise from machinery, but this will be kept to a minimum.
