Pursuant to Section 228(3)(a) of the *Local Government Regulation 2012*, Council invites open public expressions of interest before inviting written tenders for the construction of the Bundaberg Regional Aquatic Centre.

The construction of the Bundaberg Regional Aquatic Centre will be one of the largest single contracts Council has ever awarded. The construction of large pools, including the associated plant and filtration equipment, is very technical in nature and should only be undertaken by specialist sub-contractors. Any issues during construction or any settlement post construction can be extremely expensive to rectify. The proposed two stage procurement process will assist in reducing Council's risk by ensuring it is undertaken by a contractor experienced in delivering these works. The assessment criteria for the initial EOI will focus on contractors demonstrating they have sufficient experience and meet requirements around insurances, and Corporate Social Responsibilities.
