

# Sewer System Upgrade

## Limpus Crescent – Kalkie

Issue 1– April 2022

Work will commence in May 2022 on a \$140,000 infrastructure project to bypass and decommission the existing Sewerage pump station and extend the Sewer gravity main from Limpus Crescent to Balaam Drive.

This project is being undertaken to deliver operational savings by decommissioning and bypassing an older pump station that requires upgrades to its infrastructure and controls.

Works include the excavation and installation of new pipework and three access chambers to allow the new Sewer gravity main to bypass the existing Sewerage pump station. The new pipeline is indicated with yellow dashes on the attached overhead photograph. This work will be carried out by Council's Water Services team and external contractors.

Work is expected to be undertaken in May and July 2022, Monday to Friday between the hours of 6.00 am and 5.00 pm.

Bundaberg Regional Council acknowledges that construction work can cause disruption, so we thank residents for their patience and co-operation while we upgrade the sewer infrastructure in this area. Should you have any concerns or queries, please call Council's Site Manager.
