What is happening?

An upgrade the control switchboard at Wattle Street sewerage pumping station in Thabeban which includes:

- Identification of property boundaries.
- Installation of new power supply pole to the station.
- Swap over of the old to new switchboard.

The area of work is marked in yellow on the adjacent overhead photograph.

Why Upgrade?

- Ensure that Council's installations conform to the current electrical standards.
- Latest control and monitoring systems are utilised at the station.

When

May and June 2022, Monday to Friday between the hours of 6.00 am and 5.00 pm.

Who is conducting the works?

This work will be carried out by Council's Water Services team and external contractors.

Impact

The sewer system of the area is not expected to be affected by these works.

Cost
