Pettigrew Drive Sewerage Pump Station – Kalkie

Issue 1– February 2023

What is happening?

An upgrade of the control switchboard at Pettigrew Drive sewerage pumping station in Kalkie, which includes:

- Identification of property boundaries.
- Installation of a new power supply conduit.
- Swap over of the old to new switchboard.
- Repair of retaining wall and access hatches.

The area of work is marked in yellow on the adjacent overhead photograph.

Why Upgrade?

- Ensure that Council's installations conform to the current electrical standards.
- Latest control and monitoring systems are utilised at the station.

When

March to June 2023, Monday to Friday between the hours of 7am and 4pm.

Who is conducting the works?

This work will be carried out by Council's Water Services team and external contractors.

Impact

The sewer system of the area is not expected to be affected by these works.

Cost

\$80,000
