

# Water Infrastructure Maintenance

## Branyan Water Treatment Plant – Branyan

Issue 1– May 2023

### What is happening?

As part of Water Services maintenance program, the Branyan WTP Reactivators are scheduled for a coating refurbishment. Works that will take place within the treatment plant's grounds include:

- Construction and installation of access scaffolding and dust encapsulation systems.
- Water pressure cleaning and abrasive blasting.
- Application of protective coatings.

The area of work is marked in yellow on the adjacent overhead photograph, 8 Bocks Road Branyan.

### Impact from the works?

There will be some noise pollution created during the surface preparation of the metal components. This part of the operation is expected to take up to 4 days to complete for each tank, between the hours of 8am and 4pm weekdays. Affected residents will be advised a week prior to this operation commencing.

### When

The project is expected to run from 22<sup>nd</sup> May to 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2023, Monday to Saturday between the hours of 7am and 5pm.

### Who is conducting the works?

This work will be carried out by contractors and managed by Council staff.
