

How does it work?

The voucher system entitles the owner of a residential property within the Bundaberg Regional Council area to two Waste Disposal Vouchers. Vouchers are issued against the residential property and are not transferable to residents of another property. If you are a landlord please pass the vouchers on to your tenant/s.

How to use the vouchers

Present your single use voucher at the waste facility gatehouse where a staff member will assess your load.

What can be disposed of?

Single use vouchers are valid for the disposal of self-hauled domestic mixed waste (maximum 500 kg per visit) at any of Bundaberg Regional Council's waste facilities. Loads may be inspected on arrival as part of the disposal process. Charges will apply for commercial waste disposal.

Standard domestic load

One voucher per sedan, station wagon, van, utility, or trailer.

Waste types not included

Vouchers cannot be used for the disposal of tyres, solar panels, asbestos, regulated waste, commercial waste or dead animals. These items will continue to incur a cost for disposal as per Council's Waste Disposal Fees Schedule.

How long are vouchers valid?

Vouchers are valid until 31 August 2025.

Recyclable items

Recyclable items will be requested to be separated from the waste as this minimises what is sent to landfill.

Lost and unused vouchers

Once vouchers expire they cannot be redeemed. If you lose a voucher, please contact Council on 1300 883 699.

Terms and conditions of use

- Single use voucher must be presented at the time of disposal
- The person delivering the waste may be required to show whoto ID and allow the load to be accessible for inspection.
- Only one voucher redeemable per "standard domestic load"
- Standard domestic load is defined as waste delivered in a sedan, station wagon, van, utility, or trailer
- Vouchers are valid for self-haul domestic residential waste disposal only and cannot be redeemed by any commercial operators
- Any loads in excess of 500 kg shall be charged at the applicable fee
- EXCLUDES disposal of dead animals, tyres, solar panels, asbestos and other hazardous wastes.
- Gross Vehicle Mass (GVM) must be less than 4 tonnes
 (ie. average car, sedan, station wagon, utility or 4WD with or without trailer)
