



Kendalls Road Pathway Construction

Bundaberg Regional Council has appointed Kerb Placers as Principal Contractor to undertake new concrete pathway works on Kendalls Road, Avoca. The works are from Takalvan Street to Mott Street as highlighted in red on the map above, with a pedestrian refuge crossing adjacent to the Argyle Gardens driveway access.

Construction of 100m of pathway has been done to accommodate a TMR planned footpath. The construction will recommence at end of February and will be completed mid-April, weather permitting. Activities are expected to be carried out between the hours of 6:30 am and 6:00 pm Monday to Friday.

Works will be undertaken under a Traffic Guidance Scheme. Access to properties adjoining the work areas will be maintained during the construction period. Private properties will not be affected during the construction period.

Residents can expect changes to traffic conditions during this time and minor delays may be experienced.

The Principal Contractor will provide suitable arrangements to maintain waste collection services where these are provided, during the construction period.

Bundaberg Regional Council is aware of the inconvenience this work causes and thanks businesses, residents, and road users in advance for their patience and co-operation.
