







Tantitha Park playground upgrade newsletter

February 2024

Project

Bundaberg Regional Council will be installing a new playground in Tantitha Park located at 34 Currawong Road, Gooburrum. This upgrade will replace aging equipment and provide new play facilities to support the recreational needs of the community. This project is funded under Bundaberg Regional Council's Capital Works Program 2023 – 2024.

Upgrades

The playground upgrade will include a 4-metre double swing, a 3.2 metre track ride and a treehouse play unit. The track ride allows users to glide back and forth while holding onto a handle suspended along an overhead rail and the treehouse play unit includes two slides, access stairs and climbing options. The new playground will be re-located within the boundaries of the park to take advantage of the natural shade provided by surrounding trees. The equipment will not be placed underneath trees. Please note that playgrounds removed from Council parks cannot be sold or donated to the community as they no longer meet current Australian standards.

Shelter

The existing shelter will be removed to allow for the installation of the new playground, once the new playground has been installed a new shelter will be added. This work will be completed by 30 June 2024.
