Tips for managing household waste



Recycling

- Fold boxes to save space
- **Remove lids** from drink bottles and containers
- No need to crush tins and cans
- Rinse recyclables for better end product
- Never place sharps or medical waste in your recycle bin
- **Do not overfill** or jam rubbish in the bin/s
- **Do not place** large, dangerous or hazardous items in the bin
- Maximum bin weight 75 kg
 Excessive weight = no rubbish collection
- Free up space compost food and garden waste

Place bins 30 cm apart and one metre away from other objects like cars, power poles, trees etc.
