





# **Early Years Playgroup**




As Easter fast approaches, the Children at our Early Years Playgroup have been making and decorating their Easter egg baskets.

Our reliable transport Volunteer Robert has had a little mishap and broken his arm, so for those of you who are used to seeing him on trips to Bundaberg, you will miss him for the next few weeks while he recovers.

Robert's situation has reminded us all of the importance of registering for Carers Wellways. Robert is the main and fulltime carer for his mother and with this unexpected situation he has found himself stuck trying to work out who can assist his mother whilst he is out of action.

Please if you are the main carer in your home, consider registering for Carer Wellways, information below:

#### **What is Carers Wellways?**

Carers Wellways provides in-person, phone and online services and support to Australia's 2.65 million unpaid carers.

#### What services does Carers Wellways provide for carers?

- Carer Support Planning
   To help you identify what areas of support will best help you in your caring role
   and to develop a simple plan for ongoing support.
- Counselling
   If you're feeling stressed or overwhelmed, you can talk it through in a series of individual or group sessions with a professional counsellor.
- In-person Peer Support
   Get together with other carers to catch up, make connections and share stories,
   knowledge and experience.
- Facilitated Coaching
   One-on-one support with a coach to help you to make positive changes to your own life by setting goals and working on a plan to achieve these goals.
- Tailored Support Packages
   Practical assistance to ensure you have access to the resources you need when caring for someone, such as items to assist in your caring role and short-term respite.
- Emergency Respite Care
   If something urgent or unforeseen happens that prevents you from being able to be there for the person you support, we can make sure they are looked after.

   Emergency respite is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

#### **How do I contact Carers Wellways?**

By calling **1800 422 737** Monday to Friday between 8am and 5pm, you can talk to a Carer Gateway service provider who will help you access services and support.







### **Ocean Interactive Experience**

Drop into the Childers Library over the next few months to experience hands on ocean-themed exploration and play with the little one in your life! The display will be at the Library from Monday 25 March to Saturday 4 May.

Oxford, 1914. When the young men are drawn away to fight, it is the women who must keep going. Twin sisters Peggy and Maude work in the bindery at Oxford University Press in Jericho. Peggy is intelligent, ambitious and dreams of studying - but is often reminded that her job is to bind the books, not read them. Maude, meanwhile, is extraordinary and vulnerable. She wants nothing more than what she has, and Peggy must watch over her. When refugees arrive from devastated Belgium, it sends ripples through the community and the sisters' lives. Peggy begins to see the possibility of another future: one where she can use her intellect and not just her hands. But as war and illness reshape her world, it is love, and the responsibility that comes with it, that threaten to hold her back.



## **Childers Library**



Esme, she spends her childhood in the Scriptorium, an Oxford Garden shed in which her father and a team of lexicographers are collecting words for the very first Oxford English Dictionary. One day a slip of paper containing the word bondmaid flutters beneath the table. Learning that the word means 'slave girl,' begins to collect other words that have been discarded or neglected by the dictionary men. As she grows up, Esme realises that words and meanings relating to women's and common folks' experiences often go unrecorded. So, she begins to search out words for her own dictionary: the Dictionary of Lost Words. To do so, she must leave the sheltered world of the university and venture out to meet the people whose words will fill those pages.

#### What does a week in the life of a farm worker look like?

Exhibition curator, artist and researcher Dr. Kaya Barry set out to discover this, handing out disposable cameras to over 30 seasonal farm workers across regional Queensland locations in 2022 – 2024. The photographs that came back ranging from the evocative landscapes to the beautifully mundane moments, show their typical daily lives while in Australia: toiling in the fields, on shuttle buses to and from the farms, living in shared dormitories, and enjoying their well-deserved days off.
