

Adoption Of Temporary Local Planning Instrument 2/2018 – Cordalba To Wallaville Cane Railway Infrastructure

Notice is given under the Planning Act 2016 that on 13 November 2018, Bundaberg Regional Council resolved to adopt Temporary Local Planning Instrument (TLPI) 2/2018 – Cordalba to Wallaville Cane Railway Infrastructure.

The TLPI applies to land between Cordalba, Booyal and Wallaville as identified in mapping included in the TLPI.

The purpose and general effect of the TLPI is to advance a key project for Cane Railway infrastructure that has potential for significant economic benefits for the Bundaberg Region and to protect the proposed Cane Railway corridor from incompatible development.

The TLPI will take effect on 16 November 2018 and will cease to have effect on 16 November 2020 unless repealed prior to this date.
