



Ferry Hills Road – Floodway Replacement

Bundaberg Regional Council has appointed Keltone Constructions Pty Ltd as Principal Contractor to undertake Floodway Replacement works on Ferry Hills Road, Wallaville. The works will be undertaken as highlighted in red on the map above.

Work is planned to commence mid-September with completion expected by mid-December 2025. Activities are expected to be carried out between the hours of 6:00 am and 6:00 pm Monday to Friday, with works on Saturday and Sunday if required.

Traffic control measures will be utilised during construction works, with a full road closure in place for the duration of the project. Detour signage will be in place directing traffic to Booths Rd & Currajong Farm Rd. Refer to the detour plan located overleaf.

Access to private properties adjoining the work areas will be maintained during the construction period. Residents can expect changes to traffic conditions during this time and delays may be experienced.

Bundaberg Regional Council is aware of the inconvenience this work causes and thanks residents, and road users in advance for their patience and co-operation.
