Bundaberg Regional Council has appointed Boral Asphalt as Principal Contractor's to undertake Asphalt Pavement Repairs and Flat Boarding works in the Buxton Area in preparation of bitumen resealing forecasted for the 2026/2027 FY.

When will the works happen?

Works will take place on Friday 09th January 2026.

Why are the works taking place?

These works are being carried out in preparation of the Bitumen Resealing scheduled from January 2027, the asphalt works are being carried out in advance to allow sufficient time for the asphalt to oxidise/settle prior to the bitumen sealing.

Working hours & Traffic Management

Day works: 6:30am to 6:00pm, Monday to Saturday. Works will be undertaken under Traffic Control Stop / Slow.

Residents directly affected by the works will receive a letterbox notice at least 24-48 hours before day works begin.

Traffic and access

Traffic control and temporary road closures will be in place during construction. Local access will be maintained, and residents will still be able to access their properties throughout the works. Please be aware that traffic conditions will change, and some delays may occur during this time.

Waste collection

Arrangements will be made by Boral Asphalt to ensure waste collection services continue during the construction period.

Council understands that construction works can be inconvenient and thanks the community for their patience and understanding while these important improvements are carried out.
