



Pathway Renewal- Burnett Street

Issue 1 – February 2026

Bundaberg Regional Council has appointed Dreampour Pty Ltd (Kerb Placers) as the Principal Contractor to undertake Construction Works on Burnett Street Pathway (See attached map for approx. location in blue)

When will the works happen?

- Civil works are expected to start Monday 2 March 2026 and will take approximately Four - Five weeks.
- All works are expected to be completed by late March / early April 2026, weather permitting.

Working Hours & Traffic Management

- **Day works:** 6:30am to 6:00pm, Monday to Saturday

Residents directly affected by the works will receive a letterbox notice at least 72 hours before day or night works begin.

Traffic and Access

Traffic control and temporary lane closures will be in place during construction. Local access will be maintained, and residents will still be able to access their properties throughout the works.

Please be aware that traffic conditions will change, and some delays may occur during this time.

Waste Collection

Arrangements will be made by Dreampour Pty Ltd to ensure waste collection services continue during the construction period.
