### How does it work?

Two waste vouchers are issued to owners of each eligible residential property within the Bundaberg Regional Council area. Vouchers are registered against the property address for residents of that property to use. Council recommends landlords pass vouchers on to tenant/s.

### How to use the vouchers

Present your single use voucher at the waste facility gatehouse where a staff member will assess your load and give further instructions.

### What can be disposed of?

Single use vouchers are valid for the disposal of self-hauled domestic mixed or green waste (maximum 500 kg per visit) at any of Bundaberg Regional Council's waste facilities. Loads may be inspected on arrival as part of the disposal process. Charges will apply for commercial waste disposal.

### Standard domestic load

One voucher per sedan, station wagon, van, utility, or trailer.

### Waste types not included

Vouchers cannot be used for the disposal of tyres, solar panels, asbestos, regulated waste, commercial waste or dead animals. These items will continue to incur a cost for disposal as per Council's Waste Disposal Fees Schedule.

### How long are vouchers valid?

One year. Vouchers are valid until 31 August 2026.

### Recyclable items

Recyclable items should be separated to minimise the amount of waste sent to landfill.

### Lost and unused vouchers

Once vouchers expire they cannot be redeemed. If you lose a valid voucher, please contact Council on 1300 883 699.
