# **Community Group of the Year**

This award recognises outstanding achievement by a group or organisation fostering community spirit, which has resulted in positive outcomes for the Bundaberg Region.

## Nomination criteria for community group:

Contributions can be made in any area that supports the advancement and wellbeing of the community.

Consideration will be given to the nominee's achievements in the year immediately prior to receiving the award, as well as past achievements and ongoing contribution to the community.

#### The panel will also consider:

- · The level of community involvement
- · Benefits to the community and local business
- · Ability of the event to increase tourism
- Inclusivity

# Eligibility criteria:

- Nominated groups or organisations must be located within the Bundaberg Regional Council area
- No weight is given to the number of times a person is nominated

## **Judging process:**

Nominations will be reviewed by the appointed judging panel. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
